

Accessibility Statement



This is an accessibility statement from A Nation of Hope. A Nation of Hope is committed to adhering to accessibility laws and regulations, including the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act, to ensure that our website is usable by all individuals, including those with disabilities. We regularly review and test our website to identify and resolve any accessibility issues and to implement updates as needed to improve user experience. Users are welcome to use third-party accessibility tools and plugins to ensure our website remains accessible to users who rely on screen readers or need to adjust display settings such as text size and contrast.

1. Conformance Status

The Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) define requirements for designers and developers to improve accessibility for people with disabilities. It defines three levels of conformance: Level A, Level AA, and Level AAA. A Nation of Hope is partially conformant with WCAG 2.1 level AA. Partially conformant means that some parts of the content do not fully conform to the accessibility standard.

2. Additional Accessibility Considerations

Although our goal is WCAG 2.1 Level AA conformance across all areas of our website, we have also applied some Level AAA Success Criteria: Images of text are only used for decorative purposes. Re-authentication after a session expires does not cause loss of data when users are filling out forms or engaging with interactive content. Some videos, images, and audio files may not have sign language interpretation.
